The Advanced Placement offering in Art History is designed to provide the same benefits to high school students as those provided by an introductory college course in art history: an understanding and enjoyment of architecture, sculpture, painting, and other art forms within historical and cultural contexts. Students will learn to look at works of art critically, with intelligence and sensitivity, and analyze what they see.
