

FAQ's: SCRIP Program

The SCRIP program is a fundraising program that allows participating merchants to contribute a percentage of purchases to St. Francis High School's scholarship program.

Electronic SCRIP is very similar to earning mileage when using your credit card. You register your credit, debit, and grocery club cards at www.eScrip.com and www.schoolpop.com. They track your purchases with participating merchants and collect a percentage of your purchases that they then forward to St. Francis.

What is eScrip?

Rather than purchasing paper SCRIP before you spend your money, eScrip allows you the convenience of registering your existing grocery club cards, VISA, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, Diners Club, Debit/ATM cards and merchant cards such as OfficeMax and use them every time you shop. These merchants have agreed to donate a percentage of your expenditures to St. Francis. Just register and they do the rest for you.

NOTE: However, you must remember to re-register your Safeway club cards every year as well as update the expiration date on your credit cards as they change to ensure that eScrip continues to donate a percentage of your expenditures to St. Francis.

How do I sign up for eScrip?

Simply register online at www.escrip.com or contact our SCRIP coordinator for more assistance.

Can I have family members register their cards at eScrip?

Yes, eScrip as merchants that participate across the United States so you can have them register and list St. Francis as the beneficiary. You can also include all household family cards under one supporter ID. If both spouses have the same credit card number, you only need to list it once. If they have different card numbers, list all card numbers in the database.

How will I know how much I have contributed using the eScrip program?

Monthly statements are available online by accessing "My eScrip" at www.eScrip.com. St. Francis also receives a consolidated report showing the amount contributed in your name.

What is SchoolPop?

SchoolPop is very similar to eScrip. You register your credit and debit cards at their site. When you are interested in purchasing anything online, go to their site first. Many times, they have shopping specials that can save you even more. Click on their Shop and Earn section and start shopping. Click on the logo of the merchant whose website you would like to visit (such as Lands End) and you will be redirected to the merchant's site. All purchases made during that online session will earn contributions to St. Francis.

Because your credit and debit cards are registered at SchoolPop, any time you purchase from participating merchants off-line through catalogs for example, you also earn contributions for St. Francis. There is no cost to you with this program. You make the purchases you normally would, but now the merchants contribute a percentage of your purchases to St. Francis!
