Auditions:Auditions:Dancers will audition intermediate to advanced level jazz and lyrical combinations on March 7th to determine proficiency of technique, musicality, and performance quality.Callbacks:Dancers may prepare a tap or pointe solo to present at callbacks on March 8th. Solos should be 30 seconds in length and not set to music. Presenting a solo is optional and allows for the dancers to demonstrate additional choreographic and technical strengths.
