

# Class of 2020 Financial Aid Information 2016-2017

We know that investing in a St. Francis Catholic High School education is a significant financial commitment, and we offer a tuition assistance program to families with demonstrated financial need.

This academic year, approximately 29% of the St. Francis student body receives financial assistance, with an average award of \$3,960.00. For those receiving financial aid, the average family size is 4 persons and the average household income is \$94,126.00.

In addition to more than \$1.2 million in tuition grants, St. Francis Catholic High School also assists students with co-curricular fees and expenses.

# **Tuition and Fees**

For the 2015-16 academic year, tuition is \$13,000 per year. However, the actual cost of educating each student at St. Francis is more than \$13,700. This gap is bridged through a variety of sources including non-tuition revenue and the fundraising efforts of our Advancement Department. In addition to tuition, there is a \$600 non-refundable registration fee and a \$75 technology fee.

### **Applying For Financial Aid**

St. Francis Catholic High School utilizes the services of Tuition Aid Data Services (TADS) to independently gather information for the awarding of tuition assistance. An application fee of \$34 is charged and paid to TADS for this service. If you have additional students at other schools that use TADS (including Jesuit) you will only need to complete one application to TADS and pay one fee.

# **Tuition Payment Options**

Tuition may be paid in one annual payment (due July 1, 2016), semi-annual payments (due July 1, 2016 and November 1, 2016) or in ten monthly payments (due July 2016 through April 2017).
