

In order to make class discussions and essay writing easier, students must obtain a personal copy of the edition of the book listed below. Please do not buy a different version or use an e-reader version.

Every student will be expected to bring her copy to class every day in the opening weeks of school.

In the first days of school, students are tested on their comprehension of the summer reading selection. In order to prepare for the objective test, students may wish to take notes on the people and central events of the book. The multiple choice questions are not difficult for anyone who has completed the reading. Students will also complete a short written response.

K12 ALERT

This is the automated system used to alert students, staff, and parents about important information. **It is important to include your student's phone number for emergency notifications.** K12 Alert is also used emergency notifications; please do not call the school in case of an alert.



Medical and Wellness

It is important to know that SFHS does not have a school nurse. If a student needs assistance she should come to the front office (please encourage her not to hide in bathrooms).

If your student needs to take medication during the day parents can fill out the medication form on the website and we can store medication in the office. We do not dispense medication, including Tylenol or Advil (students may carry one dose). **DO NOT carry or share any medications.**

Yes, please have them carry Epi pens, Inhalers, Glucagon etc.

We currently have one counselor on campus to assist with Mental/Emotional health issues. She is for triage only, not full time counseling. We will send out a form if you need to make us aware of any specifics prior to the start of school.





FRESHMAN: DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP ROUTE



