



All drivers must use the specific designated drop off/pick up sites for safety and in order to facilitate a faster, smoother flow of traffic. Traffic backups are generally caused by drivers who are not paying attention or obeying the rules. **It is important not to be on a phone, to move quickly out of the traffic lane if your student is not immediately available, and most importantly do NOT speed on campus.**

Parent Drivers of Students - DROP OFF/PICK UP

- Students should be dropped off/picked up in the designated dropoff/pickup locations only. See attached map for entrance location and drop off/pick up route through the campus.
- Plan on having your student on campus at **least 15-20** minutes prior to the start of school. The longest drop off traffic delays are from 7:40am-8:00am.
- Drivers whose students are not immediately available for pick up at 3:00pm will be asked to exit the lanes and pull into the gym lot until your student is available. There is no parking in the dropoff/pick up lines.
- Pull as far forward towards the gym before having your student enter or exit the vehicle.
- Your student should have all items with her, and be ready to load/unload into/from the vehicle. Please do not have items in the trunk as this delays the exiting of the vehicle.
- **Open the car door slowly, always look both ways, check for vehicles/safety concerns.**
- **NO** drop off from the visitor parking spaces.
- **NO** switching drivers or lane switching once you are in an established lane.
- **NO drop off inside the student parking lot.**
- **NO** pick up/drop off on M Street or in any of the surrounding neighborhoods.
- **NO** speeding, the speed limit for the SFHS parking and driving areas is 5 mph.
- **NO** being on the phone while driving.

Student Drivers - SOPHOMORE/JUNIOR/SENIOR PARKING IN STUDENT LOTS

- Student drivers must enter through the cell phone lot.
- Student drivers must have their parking permit displayed on the dashboard or rearview mirror at all times. This includes seniors with painted parking spaces.
- Plan on being on campus at **least 15-20** minutes prior to the start of school.
- Student drivers may park in any student parking space (exception only students with reserved painted spaces may use those painted spaces).
- **Open the car door slowly, always look both ways, check for vehicles/safety concerns.**
- **NO** switching drivers or lane switching once you are in an established lane.
- **NO** pick up/drop off on M Street or in any of the surrounding neighborhoods.
- **NO** being on the phone while driving.
- **NO** speeding, the speed limit for the SFHS parking and driving areas is 5 mph. Students speeding risk losing their on campus parking privileges and will not be refunded.
- Students should exit their vehicles and enter campus. There is no hanging out in vehicles in the parking lot.
