



2023 Summer Camp Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER PROGRAMS

When does summer registration begin? When does it end?

Summer Camp registration is available online and opens at **12:00 pm on February 28th, 2023**. Registration remains open until camps are filled.

Are payment plans offered?

Families have the option to pay 50% of tuition at the time of registration and the remaining 50% will be charged on an installment date. Installment dates for the second 50% payment are April 12th, 2023 or May 12th, 2023.

I accidentally signed my student up for an incorrect camp. Can I switch camps?

If spots are available, we would be happy to make registration changes. To do so, please email summer@stfrancishs.org.

What is your cancellation and refund policy?

To cancel your Camp Troubie, Camp Troubie Jr., or afternoon camp registration, please email summer@stfrancishs.org. A refund, with a deduction of \$75, will be issued if you cancel your registration *before or on* May 20, 2023. Refunds cannot be issued for cancellations after this date.

Sports Camp Refund Policy: A refund, with a deduction of \$50, will be issued if you cancel your registration *before or on* May 12th, 2023. Refunds cannot be issued for cancellations after this date.

GENERAL INFORMATION

What is the dress code for camps?

Summer dress code is casual and comfortable. Bathing suits and clothing with inappropriate language are not acceptable. Tops must cover the back and stomach.

What do sports campers need to bring with them?

Students participating in Sports Camps should refer to the "Sports Camp Information Sheet" for proper sports attire & equipment for each camp.

What materials will my daughter need for Camp Troubie or the afternoon camps?

All materials and supplies for Camp Troubie and afternoon enrichment camps are provided.

Where does my daughter go on the first day of camp?

Campers will come to the check-in table at the front of the school on the first day of camp to check in and get their name tags. Camp Troubie counselors will escort campers onto campus on the first day. After the first day of camp campers will enter campus through the St. Francis front office.

- **Check In for indoor Sport Camps:** For Basketball and Volleyball please enter through the Gymnasium doors (at the end of the pick up/drop off lanes). View this [MAP](#) for indoor camps and traffic flow directions.
- **Check in for outdoor Sport Camps:** For Soccer, Lacrosse, and Softball please go directly to the field. View this [MAP](#) for outdoor camps and traffic flow directions.

Can parents stay to watch sports camps?

Unfortunately, no. Since we cannot guarantee that parents or relatives are fingerprinted, we ask that for safety purposes, only participants remain on campus during camps. Parents may arrive up to 5 minutes before pick-up time and wait in the drop off/pick-up lane.

My student cannot attend Camp; who do I call?

What is the absence policy?

Summer camps do not have limitations on absences. However, fees are not prorated for missed camp days.
