Did You Know?

- You need 50 hours of supervised driving experience with an adult to obtain a California driver's license.
- It takes only 6
 hours of
 supervised behind
 the wheel
 experience with a
 certified driving
 instructor to get a
 California driver's
 license. Yet, a
 manicurist must
 complete 400
 hours under
 supervision to be
 licensed in the
 state of California!
- Teen drivers are at the highest risk. The crash rate (per mile driven) for 16 year olds is four times that of adult drivers.
- Having
 passengers is a
 serious distraction
 for teen drivers.
 Carrying 3 or more
 passengers
 increases the risk
 of a crash for 16
 and 17 year olds
 three-fold
 compared to
 driving alone.
