 - Begin spring of junior year

College Process

Freshman

- Begin exploring college options
- Work on schedule that will meet goals

Sophomores

- Talk more specifically about college (even take a tour or two)
- Request courses that meet selectivity of colleges

Juniors

- Begin working with college advisors
- Take SAT/ACT
- Look for colleges that offer programs that fit

Seniors – Time to Apply

- Take SAT/ACT one last time if needed
- Know applications requirements and deadlines
