



This chart offers an overview of the Math pathways available for incoming freshmen at St. Francis High School. Incoming freshmen who wish to be placed in a Math class other than Algebra 1 will need to take a Math Challenge Test.

Three years of Math are required to meet the St. Francis High School graduation requirement, but a fourth year of Math is suggested for students pursuing admission to competitive colleges and certain majors.
