HOW TO APPLY

COMPLETE THE APPLICATION

SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS AND EVALUATIONS

INCOMING 9TH GRADER (FRESHMEN):

Official copy of the 6th, 7th, and 8th-grade transcripts. Please contact your current school for an official copy of your transcripts. Please mail to SFHS, or deliver in a sealed envelope to SFHS.

INCOMING 10TH OR 11TH GRADER (SOPHOMORES & JUNIORS):

Official copy of transcripts for the previous & current high school grades. Please mail to SFHS, or deliver in a sealed envelope to SFHS.

EVALUATIONS (2):

One from the English Teacher and one from the Math Teacher. Instruct the current school to complete confidential forms and mail or email to SFHS. There is also a link available to complete the evaluation in the application portal.

Note: All transcripts & evaluations must be translated into English.

GATHER REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Copy of Passport
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of standardized test scores – TOEFL or another English proficiency exam

ENROLLMENT DECISION PROCESS

All documentation & the results from the student interview will be reviewed by the Admissions Team and a decision will be made on acceptance into St. Francis High School. At that point, we will contact the family with the next steps.
