Dear Families:

Sacramento's family of Catholic high schools is thrilled to be back welcoming our entire community for the Holy Court Volleyball games on Saturday, August 26, 2023, at St. Francis Catholic High School. This annual event is a fine tradition of good-spirited rivalry and is a chance for us to showcase our athletic accomplishments and enormous school spirit and pride. - There will be no in-and-out privileges throughout the entirety of the event.
- Everyone should park in the student parking lot and enter that parking lot from Elvas Avenue and then make an immediate right to enter the lot.
- The only entrance to the game will be at the Gym Foyer entrance on Elvas Ave. If you try to enter through any other door you will be sent all the way around the school to the correct entrance.
- For the health and safety of all student-athletes, coaches, and attendees, if you are experiencing symptoms of infectious illness, such as influenza (flu) or COVID-19, or have a member of your household with COVID-19 or awaiting test

results, stay home and do not attend the game. Staying home when sick is essential to keep COVID-19 and other infections out and prevent its spread to others.
