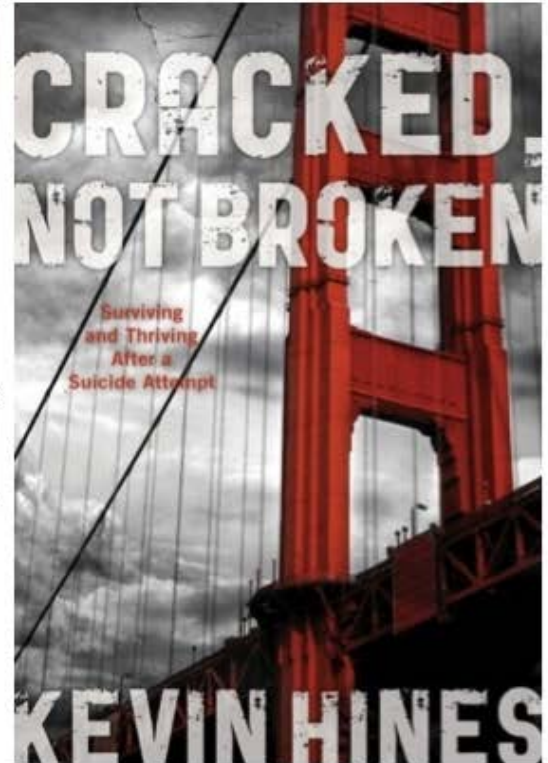
Kevin now wants to take a moment to talk with you, the parents. He will share his own story with you, address suicide prevention and provide hope for students and families dealing with mental health issues.
