DANCE: Placement Apprentice Dance Company and SF Dance Company. Please complete the Dance Interest/Audition Form if you are interested in Apprentice Dance or Dance Company.	Auditions: Dancers will audition intermediate to advanced level jazz and lyrical combinations on February 25 th to determine proficiency of technique, musicality, and performance quality. Callbacks: Dancers may prepare a tap or pointe solo to present at callback on March 1st. Solos should be 30 seconds in length and not set to music. Presenting a solo is optional and allows for the dancers to demonstrate additional choreographic and technical strengths.
