INTRO TO SHOW CHOIR meets one semester and focuses on training in dance and show choir vocals. Auditions are not required for the INTRO class, although it is suggested you audition for appropriate course placement. 	 This year's auditions will be via prepared video, not live. The video will require the following: Part 1: Performance of a short, a cappella vocal solo of your choice (1 minute max) that demonstrates range, vocal skill and personality. It need not be choreographed, but appropriate physical movement and energy should be present. Part 2: Performance of a short song/dance selection you will learn ahead of time via an instructional video.
