ACTING THEATRE ARTS I	Theatre Arts 1 is open to all students and does not require an audition. Theatre Arts I is the prerequisite for all advanced theatre classes at SFHS, and is encouraged for students interested in learning the art and process of theatre. Theatre games, audition technique, theatre history, process drama and introduction to acting styles are covered in this course. ACTING THEATRE ARTS II	The prerequisite for Theatre Arts II is Theatre Arts I or audition. Theatre Arts II is an intermediate course based on the studio program at New York University. Students learn Stanislavsky-based acting techniques, in addition to Adler, Grotowski and Meisner techniques. The second semester culminates in a performance project. Auditions for Theatre Arts II are open to students with experience in both performance and technique, and will require a monologue and/or song.  SHOW CHOIR and INTRODUCTION TO SHOW CHOIR These are both one semester classes that give PE credit. SHOW CHOIR performs year round and meets both as a club (fall) and a 1-semester class (spring). INTRO TO SHOW CHOIR meets one semester and focuses on training in dance and show choir vocals.
