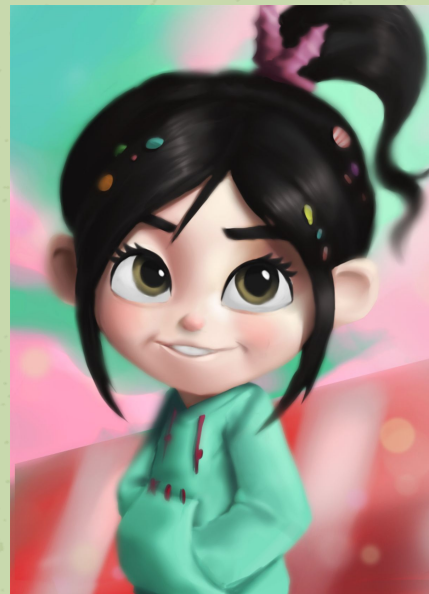

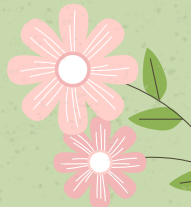

NCAA Eligibility Center

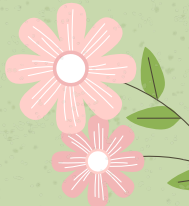
For students who plan on playing a sport in college, make sure she registers with the NCAA Eligibility Center at the end of sophomore year.
